He also oversaw Leeds City Council's first Cost Led Procurement project for Shakespeare Primary School, valued at £10 million.

He was involved in the Whinmoor Grange Horticultural Glasshouse project; Temple Green Park and Ride, the city's first park and ride, and Stourton Park and Ride, the country's first fully solar powered park and ride.
