Key successes have included work with NORA Housing, Kings Lynn, where he was responsible for developing the design RIBA work stages four to six for 160 units over three phases (value £24 million).

For Carrowbreck Housing, Norwich, he was client-side technical adviser and oversaw the construction of 14 contemporary homes designed and constructed to the Passivhaus standard.

For Bowthorpe Housing, as novated architect, he led the design team RIBA work stage four for 172 units. This is one of the largest passive developments in the country and has a value of £29 million.
